PRIZES

\$100,000 HOLE-IN-ONE

Friends of Golf, again this year, has established a cash prize of \$100,000 for a hole-in-one. \$50,000 in cash will be awarded to any registered amateur competitor who makes a hole-in-one on the 164-yard hole #16, and \$50,000 in cash will go to Friends of Golf to allow us to expand our support of junior golf.

This award includes a provision of prize restoration in which the maximum prize value is restored automatically to its original amount for each and every hole-in-one occurring during the tournament on hole #16. The same division, \$50,000 to the competitor and \$50,000 to Friends of Golf, will apply to any subsequent hole-in-one of team members.

HOLE-IN-ONE RULES

- 1. The hole-in-one must occur by an official registered amateur competitor.
- 2. No practice shots or mulligans are permitted.
- 3. Hole-in-one must be attested by two non-contestant observers stationed at the target hole, the successful competitor and one playing partner.
- 4. Competitor must submit a signed and completed scorecard.
- 5. Acceptance of hole-in-one award of a car or cash subjects recipient to forfeiture of amateur status (USGA Rules of Golf).

Not many people have reached the pinnacle of two professions simultaneously, but that is what Peter Kostis has accomplished in golf broadcasting and instruction.

Peter Kostis had a passion for teaching as an assistant professional that quickly grew as he studied the greats of the game. In 1974, he was named one of the original head instructors of the Golf Digest Schools, collaborating on a daily basis with playing legends Sam Snead, Paul Runyan and Bob Toski, and teaching icons Jim Flick, Davis Love Jr. and Jack Lumpkin. He has given more than 150,000 lessons in over 20 countries across the globe, including Paul Casey and major champions Bernhard Langer, Mark Calcavecchia and Grace Park.

In addition to being one of the game's most respected instructors, Kostis has simultaneously crafted a 30-year announcing career that began with the 1989 Ryder Cup at The Belfry. Since then, he covered 29 consecutive Masters, 27 PGA Championships and every Ryder Cup from 1989-2004, among hundreds of other golf events for CBS Sports.

During his time as a teacher and a television analyst, Peter has been in both the <u>Golf Magazine</u> *Top 100 Teacher* and the <u>Golf Digest</u> *Top 50 Teacher List* every year since their inception. His reputation as an innovator as both an instructor and an announcer earned him an Emmy for his Konica-Minolta Bizhub Swingvision analysis on CBS.

Lurie Children's Hospital, Center on Halsted, Lincoln Park Zoo, Shedd Aquarium, and University of Chicago Crime Lab, as well as national organizations such as NAACP Legal Defense Fund, Navy SEAL Foundation, and Teach For America. They founded the BMCR Gledhill Foundation to instill in their children the responsibility, commitment, and joy of serving and lifting others. The foundation focuses primarily on access, education, and leadership development. The Foundation recently underwrote the transformation of the student LGBTQ center on the campus of Brown University and invested in Principal leadership development in Chicago's public schools.

Brent has played golf since he was just seven years old and cherishes the game's lessons in integrity, patience, humility, and resilience. He and Katie are members of Glen View Club (Golf, Illinois) and Tranquilo Golf Club (Golden Oak, Florida). Formerly, while living in England, they were members of Skibo Castle in the Scottish Highlands.

THE BEN HOGAN TROPHY



TOM HARMON

BEN HOGAN

Famed Heisman Trophy (1940) football great Tom Harmon realized one of his final dreams posthumously, as he died a few weeks before the April 23, 1990 presentation of the first Ben Hogan Trophy.

Bel-Air member Harmon, as the 1989 Chairman of the Friends of Golf Tournament, was determined to create an award along the lines of his own Heisman Trophy. As a tribute to greatness in his new love, the game of golf, Tom was able to gain the endorsement of his friend, the immortal Ben Hogan.

Hogan's mystique identifies with excellence through dedicated and tireless pursuit of perfection. This identity is transferred to the beautiful Waterford crystal trophy displayed at Bel-Air.



Annually, until 2001, the college Golf Coaches Association of America selected the top college golfer-academic as the winner of the Hogan Trophy. The Colonial Club, in Hogan's home town of Ft. Worth, joined FOG as a co-sponsor. The top amateur golfer, as selected by the GCAA, is presented the Hogan Award annually in May at the Colonial Club. The permanent trophy, a replica of which is given to the college represented by the winning player, remains at its base at Bel-Air Country Club.

Ben Hogan's passing in 1997 brought a most remarkable golfing career to an end; but the Trophy carrying his name will preserve the memory of the man and his extraordinary achievements, together with honoring the young golfers who have combined golfing and academic achievement, something Hogan would have wanted.

On June 4, 2021, the three finalists were honored at a luncheon held at Colonial Country Club. Florida State senior John Pak was then named as the 2021 recipient of the Ben Hogan Trophy Award. The other two finalists were University of Texas junior Pierceson Coody and University of Georgia senior Davis Thompson.
