PRIZES

\$100,000 HOLE-IN-ONE

Friends of Golf, again this year, has established a cash prize of \$100,000 for a hole-in-one. \$50,000 in cash will be awarded to any registered amateur competitor who makes a hole-in-one on the 164-yard hole #3, and \$50,000 in cash will go to Friends of Golf to allow us to expand our support of junior golf.

This award includes a provision of prize restoration in which the maximum prize value is restored automatically to its original amount for each and every hole-in-one occurring during the tournament on hole #3. The same division, \$50,000 to the competitor and \$50,000 to Friends of Golf, will apply to any subsequent hole-in-one of team members.

HOLE-IN-ONE RULES

- 1. The hole-in-one must occur by an official registered amateur competitor.
- 2. No practice shots or mulligans are permitted.
- 3. Hole-in-one must be attested by two non-contestant observers stationed at the target hole, the successful competitor and one playing partner.
- 4. Competitor must submit a signed and completed scorecard.



CONGRATULATIONS 2022 HONOREE COLLIN MORIKAWA

Morikawa, who was born in Los Angeles and attended La Canada High School, has already found success on the PGA Tour since he graduated from UC Berkeley and finished as a runner-up for the Ben Hogan Trophy in 2018 and 2019.

In his brief PGA career, Morikawa already has five wins including a World Golf Championship victory and two major golf championships: the 2020 PGA Championship and the 2021 British Open. Morikawa had a brilliant amateur career, winning five times and spending three weeks as #1 on the World Golf Amateur Ranking. As a member of the 2021 Ryder Cup, he went 3-0-1 and finished tied for third in the 2020 Olympics. As of this writing the 25-year-old has earned over \$17 million and ranks in the Top 10 in the Official World Golf Rankings.

2022 KEN VENTURI "SPIRIT OF GIVING" AWARD RECIPIENT AL MICHAELS



Friends of Golf (FOG) announced that legendary broadcaster **Al Michaels** will be the 2022 recipient of the Ken Venturi Spirit of Giving Award. The award which bears the name of Venturi, due to his long-time support and participation in FOG, will be presented to Michaels during the 2022 FOG Charity Golf Tournament scheduled for Monday, October 3rd at Bel-Air Country Club.

Michaels' career has been full of highlights, awards, and achievements including eight Emmys. He got his announcing career started as color commentator for the Los Angeles Lakers radio broadcasts next to Chick Hearn. His travels then took him to Hawaii, Cincinnati, San Francisco, and NBC before landing at ABC for three decades. Along the way, Michaels has announced college basketball, minor and major league baseball, horse racing, boxing, NBA and NFL, college football, ice skating, and of course, hockey, where his historic line, "Do you believe in miracles?" followed the USA's upset of the Soviet Union at the 1980 Winter Olympics. He returned to NBC in 2006 to call Sunday Night Football. Recently, Michaels finalized an agreement with Amazon to call play-by-play for their exclusive Thursday Night Football games alongside analyst Kirk Herbstreit.

THE BEN HOGAN TROPHY



TOM HARMON

BEN HOGAN

Famed Heisman Trophy (1940) football great Tom Harmon realized one of his final dreams posthumously, as he died a few weeks before the April 23, 1990 presentation of the first Ben Hogan Trophy.

Bel-Air member Harmon, as the 1989 Chairman of the Friends of Golf Tournament, was determined to create an award along the lines of his own Heisman Trophy. As a tribute to greatness in his new love, the game of golf, Tom was able to gain the endorsement of his friend, the immortal Ben Hogan.



Hogan's mystique identifies with excellence through dedicated and tireless pursuit of perfection. This identity is transferred to the beautiful Waterford crystal trophy displayed at Bel-Air.

Annually, until 2001, the college Golf Coaches Association of America selected the top college golfer-academic as the winner of the Hogan Trophy. The Colonial Club, in Hogan's home town of Ft. Worth, joined FOG as a co-sponsor. The top amateur golfer, as selected by the GCAA, is presented the Hogan Award annually in May at the Colonial Club. The permanent trophy, a replica of which is given to the college represented by the winning player, remains at its base at Bel-Air Country Club.

Ben Hogan's passing in 1997 brought a most remarkable golfing career to an end; but the Trophy carrying his name will preserve the memory of the man and his extraordinary achievements, together with honoring the young golfers who have combined golfing and academic achievement, something Hogan would have wanted.

On June 4, 2021, the three finalists were honored at a luncheon held at Colonial Country Club. Florida State senior John Pak was then named as the 2021 recipient of the Ben Hogan Trophy Award. The other two finalists were University of Texas junior Pierceson Coody and University of Georgia senior Davis Thompson.
