FOG supports student athlete golfers by instilling the values of honesty, ethics, and fellowship with a true appreciation for the game. From the time boys and girls enter grade school through the end of their college experience, FOG makes it possible for aspiring junior golfers (irrespective of economic standing) to play, compete and excel in this exceptional sport.

FOG also backs a number of leading national amateur golf awards including The Ben Hogan Trophy, presented each year to the top male college golfer and The Dinah Shore Trophy, which is similarly presented to the top female golfer through a joint venture with the LPGA Foundation. ### **PRIZES**

### \$100,000 HOLE-IN-ONE

Friends of Golf, again this year, has established a cash prize of \$100,000 for a hole-in-one. \$50,000 in cash will be awarded to any registered amateur competitor who makes a hole-in-one on the 164-yard hole #3, and \$50,000 in cash will go to Friends of Golf to allow us to expand our support of junior golf.

This award includes a provision of prize restoration in which the maximum prize value is restored automatically to its original amount for each and every hole-in-one occurring during the tournament on hole #3. The same division, \$50,000 to the competitor and \$50,000 to Friends of Golf, will apply to any subsequent hole-in-one of team members. In 2022, Steve Russell was the first to make a HIO in over two decades.

### **HOLE-IN-ONE RULES**

- 1. The hole-in-one must occur by an official registered amateur competitor.
- 2. No practice shots or mulligans are permitted.
- Hole-in-one must be attested by two non-contestant observers stationed at the target hole, the successful competitor and one playing partner.
- 4. Competitor must submit a signed and completed scorecard.
- 5. Acceptance of hole-in-one award of a car or cash subjects recipient to forfeiture of amateur status (USGA Rules of Golf).

### CONGRATULATIONS 2023 HONOREE

### **MAX HOMA**

This six-time PGA Tour winner is set to make his fifth U.S. Open start. Homa claimed the Wells Fargo Championship for a second time, winning at TPC Potomac at Avenel Farm. He joined Rory McIlroy as the only multiple champions of this event. Has has since won the Fortinet Championship and Farmers Insurance Open, giving him four victories in his native California. Homa's maiden PGA Tour win in the Wells Fargo was at traditional site Quail Hollow Country Club in Charlotte, N.C., but because the venue was hosting the 2022 Presidents Cup, the event was moved to TPC Potomac. Homa also owns a pair of Korn Ferry Tour victories: the 2014 BMW Charity Pro-Am and the 2016 Rust-Oleum Championship. Homa, who now lives in Scottsdale, Ariz., enjoyed a stellar amateur career that culminated being named to the victorious 2013 USA Walker Cup Team. In 2010, Homa reached the quarterfinals of the U.S. Amateur at Chambers Bay. He also won the 2013 NCAA Division I individual title for the University of California-Berkeley. He represented the United States on the victorious 2022 Presidents Cup Team.



### CONGRATULATIONS 2023 HONOREE

### **JULI INKSTER**

Considered one of the game's all-time greats, Juli Inkster is a member of the World Golf Hall of Fame. She ranks second among all active players on the LPGA Tour with 31 career victories — seven of which came in LPGA Tour Major Championships. Inkster has more wins than any other American in Solheim Cup matches and captained the Solheim Cup team to consecutive victories in 2015 & 2017. She also lead the US squad at the 2019 Solheim Cup. Juli works as part of the Fox Sports broadcast team's coverage of USGA events including the U.S. Open. The United States Golf Association (USGA) named Juli Inkster as the recipient of the 2022 Bob Jones Award, the Association's highest honor awarded for character, respect and sportsmanship in the game of golf. Known for her tireless work ethic, her commitment to education and valuing teamwork as an essential trait in golf, she continues to inspire new generations of young women to pursue their careers and enjoy the game for a lifetime.

**Tom Addis** is a past president of the PGA of America serving in 1995 and 1996 and is in the PGA Golf Professional Hall of Fame.




Addis and his wife, Susan, are the proprietors of two Rocky Mountain Chocolate franchises in Mammoth Lakes, California and live in Beaumont, California.

Addis is one of the most decorated PGA professionals in the game of golf having been selected for national awards such as the PGA of America Golf Professional of the Year, the PGA Professional Development Award, NGF's Joe Graffis Award, the Special Olympics Conrad Rehling Award; the Langley Award presented by the Northern California PGA and is a member of the PGA of America Golf Professional Hall of Fame, the Southern California PGA Hall of Fame, the Southern California Golf Association Hall of Fame and the San Diego Jr. Golf Association Hall of Fame. He has also been awarded the Golf Professional of the Year for the SCPGA in 1979 and 1989 as well as the Professional Development Award winner for the SCPGA in 1979 and 1981.

Along with serving as president of the PGA of America, Addis has served as the San Diego PGA President, the Southern California PGA President, president of the San Diego Jr. Golf Association, president of the California State Open Golf Championship and president of the California Alliance for Golf.

#### THE BEN HOGAN TROPHY



TOM HARMON

**BEN HOGAN** 

Famed Heisman Trophy (1940) football great Tom Harmon realized one of his final dreams posthumously, as he died a few weeks before the April 23, 1990 presentation of the first Ben Hogan Trophy.

Bel-Air member Harmon, as the 1989 Chairman of the Friends of Golf Tournament, was determined to create an award along the lines of his own Heisman Trophy. As a tribute to greatness in his new love, the game of golf, Tom was able to gain the endorsement of his friend, the immortal Ben Hogan.

Hogan's mystique identifies with excellence through dedicated and tireless pursuit of perfection. This identity is transferred to the beautiful Waterford crystal trophy displayed at Bel-Air.



Annually, until 2001, the college Golf Coaches Association of America selected the top college golfer-academic as the winner of the Hogan Trophy. The Colonial Club, in Hogan's home town of Ft. Worth, joined FOG as a co-sponsor. The top amateur golfer, as selected by the GCAA, is presented the Hogan Award annually in May at the Colonial Club. The permanent trophy, a replica of which is given to the college represented by the winning player, remains at its base at Bel-Air Country Club.

Ben Hogan's passing in 1997 brought a most remarkable golfing career to an end; but the Trophy carrying his name will preserve the memory of the man and his extraordinary achievements, together with honoring the young golfers who have combined golfing and academic achievement, something Hogan would have wanted.

On May 22, 2023, the No. 1 ranked player in both the WAGR and the PGA TOUR U rankings, Ludvig Aberg edged out Gordan Sargent of Vanderbilt and Michael Thorbjornsen of Stanford to join Jon Rahm as the only repeat winners in the awards' over 30-year history.
