Legendary professional golfer and Bel-Air Country Club teaching pro Eddie Merrins ("The Little Pro") and a group of Los Angelesarea golfer helped organize FOG's first annual golf tournament intended to benefit the neighboring UCLA men's golf program. Since then, FOG has hosted 42 annual charity golf tournaments at Bel-Air Country Club and honored some of the game's top stars including Jack Nicklaus, Sir Nick Faldo, Annika Sorenstam, Phil Mickelson, Brooks Koepka, Dustin Johnson, Lorena Ochoa and Collin Morikawa. FOG supports student athlete golfers by instilling the values of honesty, ethics, and fellowship with a true appreciation for the game. From the time boys and girls enter grade school through the end of their college experience, FOG makes it possible for aspiring junior golfers (irrespective of economic standing) to play, compete and excel in this exceptional sport.

FOG also backs a number of leading national amateur golf awards including The Ben Hogan Trophy, presented each year to the top male college golfer and The Dinah Shore Trophy, which is similarly presented to the top female golfer through a joint venture with the LPGA Foundation. Welcome to the **44**th **Annual FOG Charity Golf Tournament** at Bel-Air Country Club. This year, we're thrilled to have both Dottie Pepper and Joe Fields join our extraordinary list of past FOG Honorees.

Pepper, a 17-time winner on the LPGA Tour and longtime broadcaster, will be presented with *The Eddie Merrins Trophy*, named after the late legendary PGA golfer, UCLA men's golf coach and longtime teaching professional at Bel-Air Country Club, who helped launch FOG more than 40 years ago.

During her professional golf career, Pepper captured two LPGA major championships, was the Tour leader in wins during the 1992 and 1996 seasons and was a member of six Solheim Cup teams. Once her playing days were over, Pepper transferred her focus to sports broadcasting and has been at the forefront of golf media since the early 2000s. She's worked on-air for NBC, The Golf Channel, ESPN and began her current tenure with CBS in 2016.

Pepper joins such past FOG honorees as Jack Nicklaus, Arnold Palmer, Byron Nelson, Ernie Els, Phil Mickelson, Annika Sörenstam, Dustin Johnson, Lorena Ochoa, Brooks Koepka and Collin Morikawa. Last year, FOG honored six-time PGA Tour winner Max Homa and former LPGA star and Hall of Famer Juli Inkster at its 43rd annual event.

Also being honored this year with the Ken Venturi "Spirit of Giving Award" is longtime FOG board member and accomplished veteran financial services executive, Joe Fields.

Fields, who has played an instrumental role in FOG's history as a board member, most recently served as Managing Partner of Friess Associates. Additionally, he's led numerous philanthropic initiatives, including his current role as Director of the Evans Scholars Foundation. Fields joins an illustrious group of past recipients of the "Spirit of Giving Award," including Al Michaels, Vin Scully, Tom Debrowski & Joseph Sindelar, Jr. and Ely Callaway & Oliver "Chip" Brewer and last year's honoree, Tom Addis III.

\$100,000 HOLE-IN-ONE

Friends of Golf, again this year, has established a cash prize of \$100,000 for a hole-in-one. \$50,000 in cash will be awarded to any registered amateur competitor who makes a hole-in-one on the 164-yard hole #3, and \$50,000 in cash will go to Friends of Golf to allow us to expand our support of junior golf.

This award includes a provision of prize restoration in which the maximum prize value is restored automatically to its original amount for each and every hole-in-one occurring during the tournament on hole #3. The same division, \$50,000 to the competitor and \$50,000 to Friends of Golf, will apply to any subsequent hole-in-one of team members. In 2022, Steve Russell was the first to make a HIO in over two decades.

HOLE-IN-ONE RULES

- 1. The hole-in-one must occur by an official registered amateur competitor.
- 2. No practice shots or mulligans are permitted.
- 3. Hole-in-one must be attested by two non-contestant observers stationed at the target hole, the successful competitor and one playing partner.
- 4. Competitor must submit a signed and completed scorecard.
- 5. Acceptance of hole-in-one award of a car or cash subjects recipient to forfeiture of amateur status (USGA Rules of Golf).

Dottie Pepper is the lead walking reporter for CBS Sports' coverage of the PGA Tour, Masters, and PGA Championship. After an accomplished junior, college, and amateur golf career, she went on to play 17 years on the LPGA Tour—winning 17 times, including two major championships. She represented the United States six times in the Solheim Cup matches, compiling a 13-5-2 record. She is a 1987 graduate of Furman University with a B.A. in Health Sciences.

Dottie retired from competitive golf in 2004. Since then, she has covered all levels of televised golf, including every major championship, international team events, as well as national amateur championships for ESPN, Golf Channel, NBC, and CBS.


Pepper served as a member of the PGA of America Board of Directors from 2012-2015 and the NENY PGA Board of Directors from 2009-2015. She was the recipient of the 2016 William D. THE BEN HOGAN TROPHY



TOM HARMON

BEN HOGAN

Famed Heisman Trophy (1940) football great Tom Harmon realized one of his final dreams posthumously, as he died a few weeks before the April 23, 1990 presentation of the first Ben Hogan Trophy.

Bel-Air member Harmon, as the 1989 Chairman of the Friends of Golf Tournament, was determined to create an award along the lines of his own Heisman Trophy. As a tribute to greatness in his new love, the game of golf, Tom was able to gain the endorsement of his friend, the immortal Ben Hogan.



Hogan's mystique identifies with excellence through dedicated and tireless pursuit of perfection. This identity is transferred to the beautiful Waterford crystal trophy displayed at Bel-Air.

Annually, until 2001, the college Golf Coaches Association of America selected the top college golfer-academic as the winner of the Hogan Trophy. The Colonial Club, in Hogan's home town of Ft. Worth, joined FOG as a co-sponsor. The top amateur golfer, as selected by the GCAA, is presented the Hogan Award annually in May at the Colonial Club. The permanent trophy, a replica of which is given to the college represented by the winning player, remains at its base at Bel-Air Country Club.

Ben Hogan's passing in 1997 brought a most remarkable golfing career to an end; but the Trophy carrying his name will preserve the memory of the man and his extraordinary achievements, together with honoring the young golfers who have combined golfing and academic achievement, something Hogan would have wanted.

On May 20, 2024, FOG, the GCAA, and The Hogan Trophy Award Foundation announced Auburn freshman Jackson Koivun as the 2024 Ben Hogan Award recipient. Koivun joins Rickie Fowler of Oklahoma State in 2008 as the only freshmen ever to win the Ben Hogan Award. The other finalists were Georgia Tech senior Christo Lamprecht and Vanderbilt junior Gordon Sargent. All three finalists attended the black-tie dinner at Colonial Country Club in Fort Worth, Texas.






